

Let's Explore!

John wants to buy a new bicycle*. Where does Sally want to go?

* A "bicycle" is used in the city. A bicycle that is used outside the city is called a mountain bicycle.

Target Words

 - reflector light (noun): mirrors or lights placed on a bicycle for safety e.g. You should buy reflector lights for the bicycle.





Suggestions Using Let's

An easy way to make a suggestion is to say Let's ... + the action (verb).

This means you want to do the action with another person.

Examples:

- Let's go shopping!
- Let's have a party!
- Let's go out for dinner.

Accepting and Refusing Suggestions

Here's how to accept and refuse suggestions:

Accepting Suggestions	Refusing Suggestions
OK, sounds good.	I'd rather not.
Sure, that's a great idea!	I don't think so.
Why not?	Maybe not right now.
