Learning Outcome

Let's Explore!

John wants to buy a new **bicycle***. Where does Sally want to go?

* A "bicycle" is used in the city. A bicycle that is used outside the city is called a *mountain* bicycle.



Instructions: Read the text aloud.

John: I don't like this mall. There are no sports stores.
Sally: Do you want to go to a different mall?
John: I'd rather not. I'm tired of malls.
Sally: I know an amazing sports store called Sports Inc.
John: Do they have mountain bicycles there?
Sally: Sure, they have lots of those. Do you cycle?
John: Yes, I cycle in the summer. I do aerobics in the winter.
Sally: Let's go to that store.
John: Sure, that's a great idea.
Sally: I also have a coupon for 50% off clothing and accessories.
John: I can buy other equipment, like a helmet, seat or reflector lights.
Sally: You could get a new jersey, too.
John: I don't think so, I've got lots of these.
Sally: Come on, let's go!
John: OK, sounds good!

Target Words

- helmet** (noun): protection for the head
e.g. You should wear a helmet for protection.
- jersey** (noun): shirt for sports
e.g. This jersey is perfect for you.
- shorts** (noun): short pants, often used for sports
e.g. I need to get some shorts for the gym.
- bicycle** (noun): a two-wheel vehicle you move by turning your legs
e.g. I want to buy a new bicycle.
- reflector light** (noun): mirrors or lights placed on a bicycle for safety
e.g. You should buy reflector lights for the bicycle.
- to cycle** (verb): to ride a bicycle
Example: I cycle in the summer.





Learning Points

Suggestions Using Let's

An easy way to make a suggestion is to say *Let's ...* + the action (verb).

This means you want to do the action with another person.

Examples:

- *Let's go shopping!*
- *Let's have a party!*
- *Let's go out for dinner.*

Accepting and Refusing Suggestions

Here's how to accept and refuse suggestions:

Accepting Suggestions	Refusing Suggestions
OK, sounds good. Sure, that's a great idea! Why not?	I'd rather not. I don't think so. Maybe not right now.
